

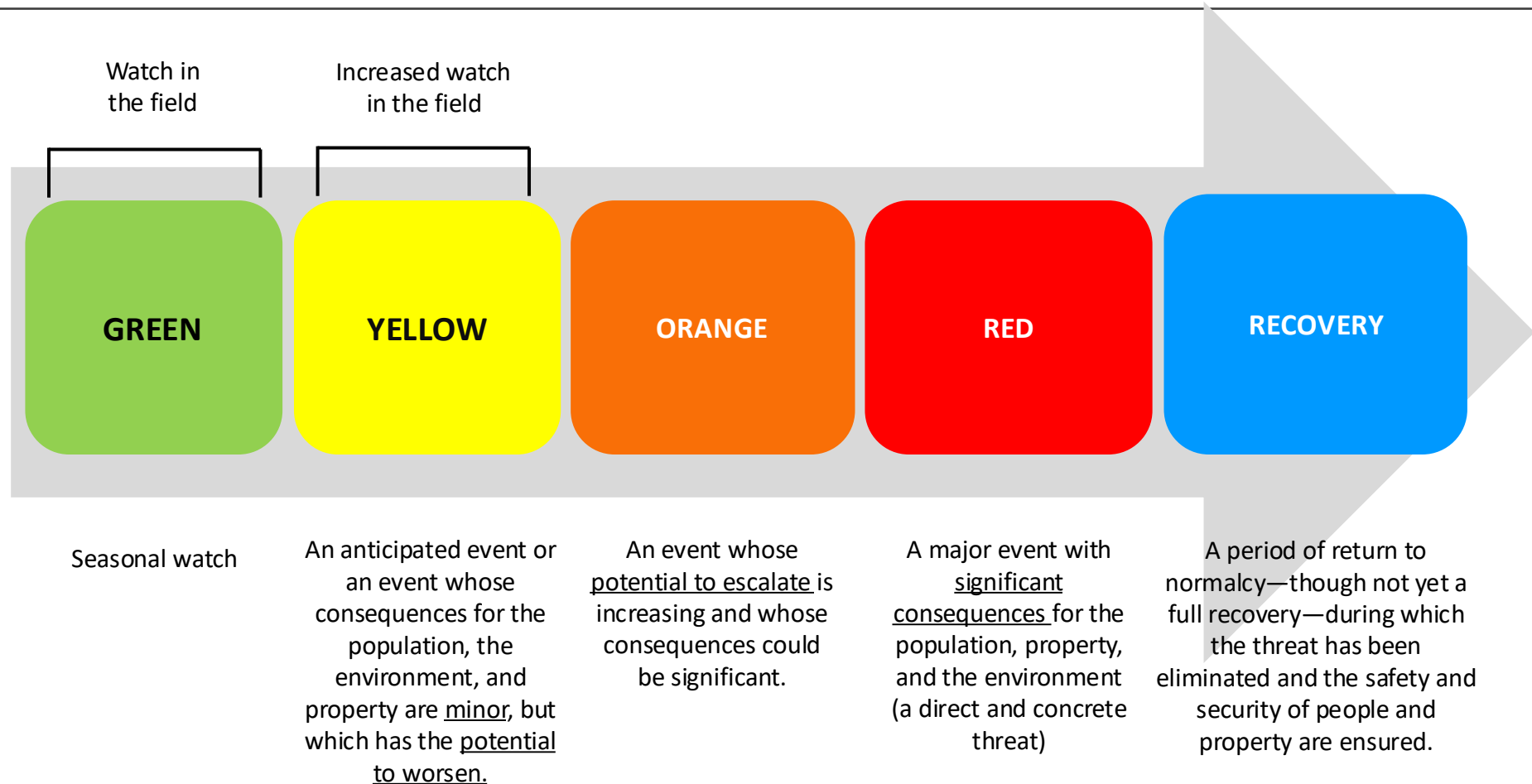


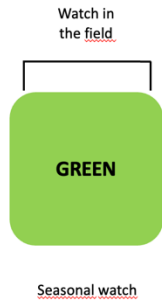

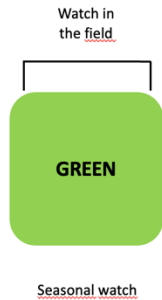


Public Works Action Plan

- Checking Multiple Weather Sites (Environnement Canada, Météomédia, etc.);
- Weather Monitoring;
- Notify the Public Works team of the possibility of a recall.

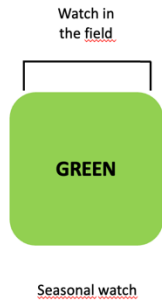

- Check the availability of the personnel required for the emergency plan.

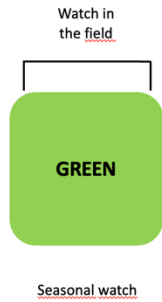

ORANGE

An event whose potential to escalate is increasing and whose consequences could be significant.

Public Works Action Plan

ORANGE : EXTREME WEATHER EMERGENCY PLAN ISSUED BY ENVIRONNEMENT CANADA

PUBLIC WORKS:

- Preparation and installation of various equipment (pumps, generators, etc.);
- Monitoring of various areas of the city by Public Works;
- Deployment of field teams (including a mechanic, if necessary);
- Engage subcontractors, if necessary (Sanivac, tree trimmers, etc.).

GENERAL MANAGEMENT:

- Analysis of the COUV's opening under restricted operations: mayor, public works department, municipal patrol, and communications services.

COMMUNICATIONS:

- Notify residents that the orange mode has been activated and provide updates as the situation evolves;
- [Urgences SADB](#): A notification informing residents via phone, text message, and/or email—depending on their preferences—that the orange alert level has been activated;
- Municipal newsletters: Information sent directly to residents' email inboxes notifying them that the orange alert has been activated;
- Social media: Posts on Facebook and Instagram announcing that Orange Alert has been activated (@VilledesADB and @sainteannedebellevue);
- Electronic signs: A message indicating that orange mode has been activated and that all other messages on the signs have been suspended.

PUBLIC WORKS:

- Public works deployment;
- Start up all equipment (pumps, generators, etc.);
- Checking alarms on infrastructure, primarily pumping stations;
- Onboarding of subcontractors;
- Notify the COUV of the situation on the ground and provide recommendations for emergency response, if necessary.

- Electronic signs: A message indicating that red mode has been activated and that all other messages on the signs have been suspended.

Public Works Action Plan

RECOVERY: LIFTING OF THE EXTREME CLIMATE EMERGENCY PLAN ISSUED BY ENVIRONNEMENT CANADA

PUBLIC WORKS:

- Checking water levels at the various pumping stations;
- A tour of the city to assess infrastructure damage, if any;
- Demobilization of teams and equipment;
- Termination of subcontractors, if applicable;
- Notify the COUV of the situation on the ground and provide recommendations for recovery, if applicable.

- Social media: Posts on Facebook and Instagram announcing that recovery mode has been activated (@VilledesADB and @sainteannedebellevue);
- Electronic signs: A message indicating that recovery mode has been activated and that all other messages on the signs will be suspended for a period of 24 hours.
